Unisys Corp. said Wednesday it completed spinning off a large part of its disk-drive plant in Santa Clara to a new company organized by the plant's managers. Sequel Inc., the new company, will service Unisys disk drives and seek to grow by arranging contracts to handle disk drives from other manufacturers -- something the Santa Clara plant couldn't do aggressively while still part of the Unisys.
