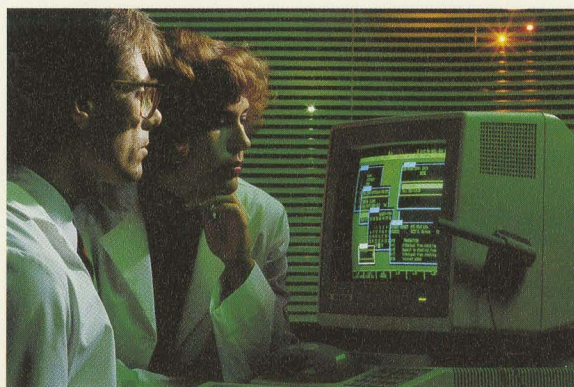

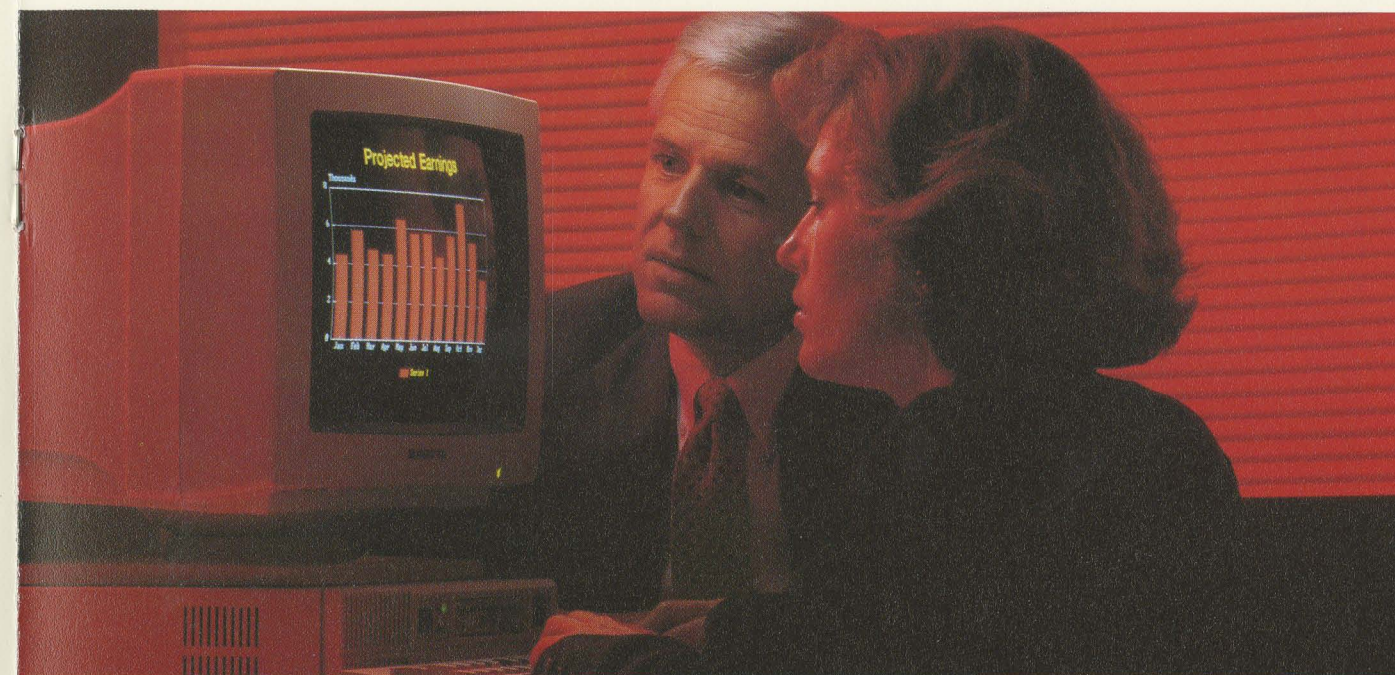
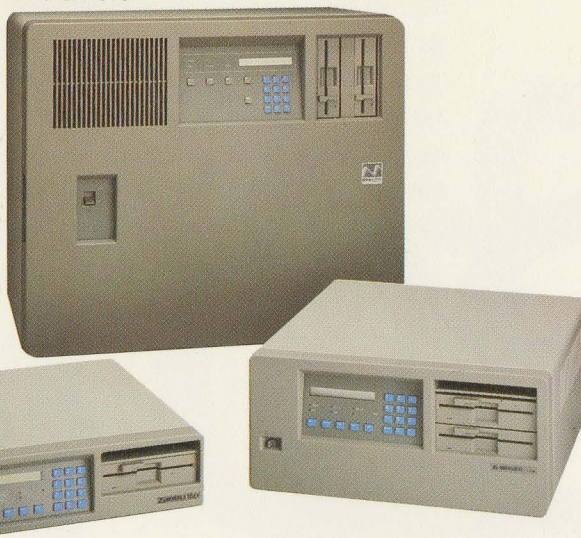

CONNECTIVITY

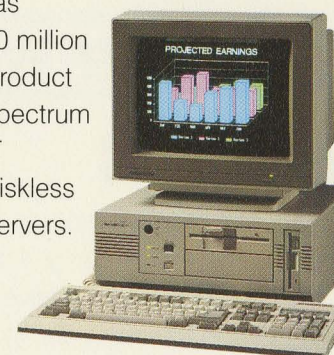

But without the provision of network services, these components of the network remain components. We provide critical installation, training and support services for our LAN customers.



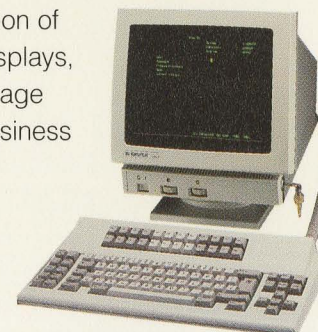
INTELLIGENT SYSTEMS

As intelligence migrates to the desktop, we have focused attention on our Intelligent Systems or PC line. By stressing compatibility and connectivity, our PC business has quadrupled to \$200 million in two years. Our product range covers the spectrum of alternatives in AT architecture from diskless PCs to 80386 file servers. We have seized the initiative by including Micro Channel Architecture systems and by offering OS/2, as well as MS-DOS.



MIDRANGE

Our thriving Midrange business embraces the integration of PCs, the provision of gateways, and the production of fixed-function displays, printers and storage devices. This business represents \$150 million in revenues.



STORAGE SYSTEMS
