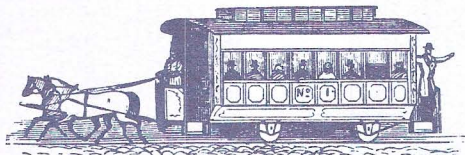


## Faster Than a Speeding 2310

## Memorex people on the move



The Equipment Group has come up with an economical new disc storage system (Model 3610) to go with IBM 1130 computers. The new system will compete with IBM's 2310 Disc Drive on a number of fronts:

First, it represents up to five times the storage capacity. The new 3610 is a 6-disc file with 10 recording surfaces. Secondly, it provides 10 times faster access than the IBM 2310 series. Average time of the Memorex 3610 system is 50 msec (milliseconds) versus 520 msec for the IBM 2310 on the 1130 system. (That's fast. It probably takes you well over 1000 milliseconds just to say, "Memorex Model 3610.")

will lease for \$750 a month including maintenance. This is about 60% of the rental cost of comparable systems.

One of the biggest advantages is that the computer requires no reprogramming when the IBM disc file is replaced by our Model 3610 with its built-in controller. The new system was designed specifically for users of the IBM 1130 computer who need to expand the capabilities of their system while at the same time protect their investment in programming and education. The built-in system control unit also means a smaller machine taking up less floor space than the IBM equipment.

Deliveries of the 3610 will begin in the second quarter of this year.

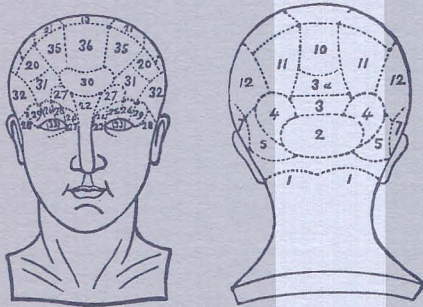
