On Friday, April 3rd, Memorex sold \$75 million of 5 1/4 % Convertible Subordinated Debentures. Enthusiastic investor response was demonstrated by the quick sale of all the debentures. The securities were offered to the public at face value (\$1,000) plus accrued interest. They are convertible into Memorex Common Stock at a rate of \$142.50 per share.

The proceeds from the sale will be applied to repay bank loans, finance capital expenditure commitments for property, plant and equipment, and to increase the Company's general funds.
