Bob Hope, formerly District Manager of the Los Angeles District, has been transferred to San Francisco as District Manager.

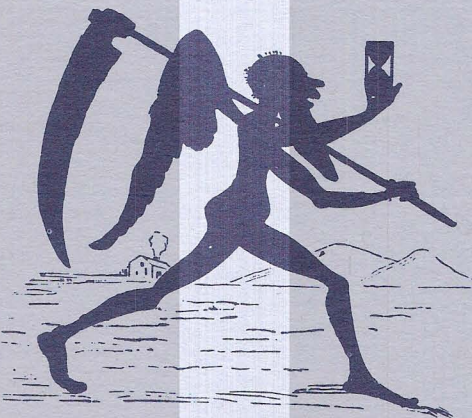
District Manager, Atlanta
