Remember that you should submit an amended income tax withholding exemption form if your exemptions have changed since you last filed an exemption certificate. Forms are available in the Personnel Offices.

This is a good time, too, to review your beneficiary designations under the Profit Sharing, Savings and Investment, and Insurance plans. (Benefit specialists usually advise this review at least once a year.) Circumstances that could suggest reviewing or changing beneficiaries include the death of a listed beneficiary, change of marital status, birth or adoption of a child, and so forth.

district social security manager. The new phone service, called "Teleservice," has been established for the convenience of social security beneficiaries and the public in general. Social Security personnel on Teleservice will answer general and specific questions about all Social Security programs including Medicare.
