


Savings Bonds Earn More Interest

A recent announcement from the U.S. Savings Bond Division of the Department of Treasury states that extensions of maturity have been granted for older Series E and H Savings Bonds and all Freedom Shares. This means that all outstanding Savings Bonds and Freedom Shares, regardless of age, will continue to earn interest.

The interest rate for Savings Bonds and Freedom Shares in the extension period will be the rate prevailing at the time they enter extension. The current rate for Bonds entering an extension is 5½ percent.

Savings Bonds can be purchased through payroll deduction. Details are available in your Group Personnel Office.


